- T. Good morning our guests, my colleagues and my dear friends, boys and girls! I am glad to see you.
- T. How are you today? I hope everything is OK. Are you ready to start our work?

T. From the very beginning I want to draw your attention to the blackboard where the quotation [kwəu'teɪʃən] from H. Longfellow, an American poet is written

«Music is the universal language of the world».

T. I think these words can be the motto of our party.

T. There is a task to solve: to improve our pronunciation and musical abilities while singing English and American songs, develop your outlook on famous singers and groups.

T. My dear friends, let's try to prove that H. Longfellow was really right.

T. What do you think about these words?

T. How do you understand these words?

P1. I think everybody understands the language of music.

P2. In my opinion Music is an international language. To my mind, all music is good.

P3. I think there is no impossible boundaries (obstacles) between the music of my country and the music of other countries. No obstacle is ever insurmountable.

T. That's right. I share your opinion. Music is an important part of our life. Each man's life begins with the mothers singing which calms him down by its melody, rhythm and introduces him to the beauty of the world. Since this first introduction man's life is ever surrounded by musical sounds and melodies.

T. If you look at the screen you can see a poem "Music" by Cecilia Perner.

T. What does the author compare music with?

*Music is a door,
An escape to a different world.
A world you make and control in your mind.
Music is a hero,
One to cheer your spirits when you are down.
Music is an enemy,
Sometimes the lyrics bring you down.
Music is your personality,
Expressed through song.
The music player,
Is you, the one holding it all together
Music is an awakening to the real world.
Its lyrics are real and true.
Music is a best friend,
One to give advice when you need it.
Music is what you think of it.
Its starts off empty and colorless,
and escalates to something more,
your own world.*

T. My dear friends, what is music for you?

T. What can you say about the role of music in your life?

T.Can you think of a day without music?

P1.It is difficult to live without music.We hear music everywhere : in the streets,at home,over the radio and on TV,in the shops, in the parks and in the concert halls, at the seaside,sometimes in the forest. We like to listen to music, we enjoy to dance to music, we play musical instruments. A music lesson is one of the favourite subjects at school. I can' t live without music.

T. What about you, P2?

P2. I think...It's difficult to live without music. Every day I spend some time listening to my favourite songs. As for me, my favourite music style is rock. The rock is very popular today because rock it not simply musical **direction/dɪ'rekʃən/-направление**, it is **youth /ju:ðz/ culture**, means of dialogue of youth, a mirror of a society. I know It was created as a way of self- expression of youth, **revolt/rɪ'vəʊlt/**

-восстание and the **protest**-/'prəʊtest/. There are a lot of groups, such as all known group The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, The Tokio Hotel, a lot of singers such as Avril Lavigne. I usually listen to music after my lessons to have a rest and to relax.

T. What is music for you, P.2?

P3. What is music for me? It's my favourite pastime. Specialists explain that music isn't only a combination of pleasant sounds. It is an art which reflects life. Modern pop songs are very tuneful ['tju:nful]-мелодичный and pleasant to listen to.

T. I know some of you are interested in Rap. What can you say about this modern music style?

P4. I am interested in Rap. Rap is a modern musical style where the singer speaks or shouts the words in time to music with a steady ['stedi] (constant) постоянный; beat-ритм. Such groups as Public Enemy or House of Pain are leaders in this style.

P5. To my mind... Music is a great power, and it can make us cry or laugh, love or feel sad. I am fond of modern pop music. If I want to listen to it I can go to music halls and concerts of popular groups. Fortunately ['fɔ:tʃəniti]- к счастью, our town is very often visited by them.

T.P5. What kind of music do you like?

P6. In my opinion, music reflects people's mood and emotions. It seems to me that music can do it because there is some invisible energy in the music. Though classical music is often associated /ə'səʊʃieitið/ with the music of the past sometimes I spend my free time listening to music by Mozart. For example his "Fourth Symphony" impresses me very much.

T.P7. Can you think of a day without music?

P7. I can't imagine my life without music. I think the power of music is in its rhythm ['riðm], in the sound and in the melody, and, of course, in the plot of it. Music is a combination of many sounds.

T. I share your opinion that the power of music is in its rhythm. Scientists proved that not melody but the rhythm of the melody affects a lot on people. I don't mind listening to jazz. Improvisation is an important part of this style, that's why a jazz song may sound a little different each time it is played. I think that jazz is a mixture of many different kinds of music, but I consider it a bit complicated.

T. What's your favourite music style, P.8?

P8. My favourite style of music is pop music, because it is breathtaking ['breθteikɪŋ] -захватывающий and full of energy. When I listen to pop music it makes me remember happy times and forget the problems of everyday life. It helps me to relax when I'm tired, and entertains me when I'd like to have fun. My

favourite group is Abba. It was formed in 1973 in Sweden. Abba's cheerful tunes made them international pop stars and one of the most successful groups of the seventies. Their most famous songs ("Waterloo", "Money, Money, Money", "Knowing Me, Knowing You", etc.) often topped European charts. Though the group doesn't exist any more, it is still popular with people of all ages. I can't but admire their style of singing. I find it fascinating and overwhelming. When I have free time I listen to their records. I also like having background music while I am working.

T.P7. Do you like dance music?

P9. Good music was meant to be loud! I don't mind listening to dance music, especially when I go to disco clubs. This style of music is catchy and I like catchy tunes. It makes me more energetic.

T.P.8, Do you like classical music?

P8. I think loud music can destroy our ears. It's a pity that many young people like to listen only to modern music. As for me I enjoy listening to classical music. I find it tuneful and appealing. Classical music is always a complex of emotions. It gives me delight, pleasure and a sense of happiness. Some pieces of classical music are really wonderful. Not long ago I listened to the First Piano Concerto [kən'ʃɔ:təu], composed by Tchaikovsky. The power of his music impressed me. The impression was overwhelming

T. What about you, P.9, is all music good for you?

P9. I don't think that all music good. The music I hate is heavy metal. I find it noisy and dreadful. When I listen to this style of music it presents to my mind pictures of dark days. Though some young people are fond of this style of music, it is not to everyone's taste.

P12. All my family love music. My mother and father approve of my tastes in music. Though they prefer to listen to classical and "bard music", they think that, on the whole, modern music is not too bad. My parents agree that each generation has its own tastes.

T. It goes without saying that music plays a very important role in people's lives. It reflects our moods and emotions. Music appeals to our hearts and transforms our feelings. It conquers our souls and enriches our minds. Besides, listening to music is the perfect way to spend free time and not to feel bored. You can hardly find a person who doesn't like or need music and who never sings or dances. Music is beauty in sounds; it is our magic source of inspiration.

T. Tastes differ. So people's musical interests range from pop and rock music, which are extremely popular nowadays, especially among young people, to classical music and opera.

T. I think singing is the best way to continue our work.

T. While we are listening to the song you can look through new words of our lesson.

P3. The common instruments used in a jazz include the cornet ['kɔ:nɪt], saxophone ['sæksəfəʊn] and trumpet ['trʌmpɪt] which usually plays solo parts.

P4. Jazz is performed in various parts of the USA

P5. Jazz music can be performed by a small group of performers or by a big band.

P6. The rhythm ['rɪðm] section is often made up of the piano and the double bass. [ˈdʌbl]--контрабас

P7. The melody and rhythm of jazz music are usually flexible ['fleksəbl] and complex.

P8. Jazz music has different styles such as cool jazz, free jazz and jazz rock

T. Though styles have come and gone (while new ones are always being created) the jazz singers, the man or a woman with the voice has always been a main stay of a genre. /zɑ:nr/

P. Louis Armstrong

T. There were a lot of famous jazz singers, such as Billy Holiday, Frank Sinatra (1915-1998), Ray Charles, Duke Ellington

T. When people think about jazz, one of the top names that comes up is Louis Armstrong. Some people even call this talented musician **the Father of Jazz**.

The passion in his music undoubtedly came from the experiences of his life.

T. What do we know about Louis Armstrong?

P1. Louis Armstrong was called the King of Jazz, he also called SATHMO- because of his mouth. He was the grandson of slavers and the son of poor people.

Louis Armstrong grew up in the rough streets of New Orleans. Louis Armstrong's father left the family right after he was born. He spent a lot of time with his grandmother in his early years. When he was old enough to begin working, he left school to help the family. He made it up to the 5th grade. He sold newspapers, did other odd jobs to support his mother but spent most of his time in one district of New Orleans where he could hear playing of local bands.

T. How did he manage to become a famous musician? How did he develop into a famous musician?

A Fateful Arrest

P2. To celebrate a new year, 11 year old Louis Armstrong decided to fire a pistol into the sky. The dangerous choice led to his arrest and eventually he was sent to a home for boys. At this home, Louis began to develop a passion for music. A local professor noticed his talent and helped Louis to develop his musical skills and discipline he would need later on in life. His fateful arrest played an important play on young Armstrong's musical life, where he received formal training and even led the schools band.

Louis Armstrong changed the way we think about music. He made the greatest influence on the development of jazz and did his best to popularize throughout the world.

T. Who was the First Lady of Jazz? -Ella Fitzgerald (1917-1996). She is considered as one of the best singers in the history of a jazz with the most influential voice in all of jazz.

T. Louis Armstrong and Ella Fitzgerald changed the way we think about music. They made the greatest influence on the development of jazz and did his best to popularize it throughout the world.

Rock music - is a type of music of African-American origin with elements of blues and jazz

Rock exists since the mid 1950's.

The word «rock» – rock – similar to «roll», «twist», «swing», «shake».

Rock music characterizes of using of electric(al) music instruments

The electric guitar is an important instrument of rock music.

Rock music characterized by execution [ɛksɪ'kju:ʃən]; выполне́ние of the songs of their own compositions.

The main centers of development of rock music – United States and Western Europe (especially UK).

Most of the texts of songs in English.

Russian rock music (the so-called. Russian rock) appeared in the USSR in 1960-1970's. and reached peak development in the 1980's., continuing to grow in 1990.

Rock music has a lot of directions: from the light of genres such as dance-rock-n-roll, pop rock, to the brutal and aggressive genres – death metal and grind.

The contents of the songs range from light and easy to dark, deep and philosophical. Most rock music is the opposite of pop music, and «Pop», although the clear distinction between the concepts of «rock» and «pop» does not exist, and many musical events on the brink between them.

T. This song was written by Sir Paul McCartney, a famous English musician of the the most commercially successful group in the history of popular music .

It was inspired by his mother, Mary, who died when he was 14. Many people thought "Mother Mary" was a biblical reference when they heard it.

McCartney had a dream one night when he was anxious. He saw his mom who had been dead for ten years or so; she came to him in his time of trouble, speaking words of wisdom. This brought him much peace when he needed it. It was this sweet dream that got him to begin writing the song.

T. Do you know these people?

T. Its «Beatles», the most commercially successful group in the history of popular music, and which achieved its success in the 60s and 70s.

T. The mix of the four personalities won the audience around the world and opened as it was said : a new era in music. Their music became the common language of the generation. But the influence of the Beatles was especially strong. Nothing expressed the youthful «pop» culture of 60s better than the Beatles, whose music quickly became internationally known.

T. "The Beatles" brought a new sound to Britain.
